5 May 2017 – 11h.30 Press Conference – Sala Viglione of the Regional Council of Piemonte, Palazzo Lascaris, Via Alfieri 15, Torino

Press Conference/debate on the inhuman destruction of the Syrian people and on the tragedy undergone by refugees in the presence of Malak Sahioni Soufi, Norberto Silva Itza and Concepción Allende Vasallo. Presentation of the forthcoming days.

Participation of journalists working for the regional press, of representatives of the Association of Journalists and of Associations working for immigrants and refugees.
